Creativity has a vital role to play in our communities, helping us to understand each other and the world we live in, communicate in languages beyond words, value the richness of diversity and stimulate inclusivity and innovation. Creativity also improves wellbeing and allows for self-discovery, collaboration develops interpersonal skills and when people are given high quality arts experiences their aspiration and self-worth flourishes.

Creativity is at the heart of everything Create does. We promote inclusivity by bringing disabled and non-disabled children together to make collaborative arts. We give young and adult carers meaningful time away from their responsibilities to invest in their own wellbeing. We create a safe space for LGBT young people to find peer-support and self expression.

These are just some examples of the creative experiences we provide for people with the least access to the arts but the most to gain from taking part.

Since 2003, we have run almost 7,000 participatory workshops, giving more than 32,000 disadvantaged and vulnerable people across the UK free access to the educational, social and health benefits of the creative arts.

Our funding comes from a variety of sources including individuals, companies, charitable trusts and events. We are delighted to have secured our first grant from Arts Council England but receive no sustainable Government funding and, as social welfare and arts budgets are reduced, are developing additional funding streams to transform more lives through creativity.

CHAMPIONS TAKE THE LEAD

Our supporters have enabled young carers to perform a Curtain Raiser for Sir Matthew Bourne's *Sleeping Beauty*; helped young fathers in prison create stories for their children; and given adults with disabilities the chance to express themselves through music and dance. Your support will provide even more opportunities.

HAYLEY'S STORY

Hayley's son Gene was in hospital due to a virus infection in his face. His temperature was over 40° and he was having regular injections and blood pressure checks. Gene was frustrated and scared but took part in ArtsAdventures, a Create project to help children cope with the stress of being in hospital.

"The session today was so fun. We weren't expecting it. Just before the music started, he had been for a scan but I could see he really started enjoying it. Having the arts in hospitals helps people forget the pain ... you can play and have fun."

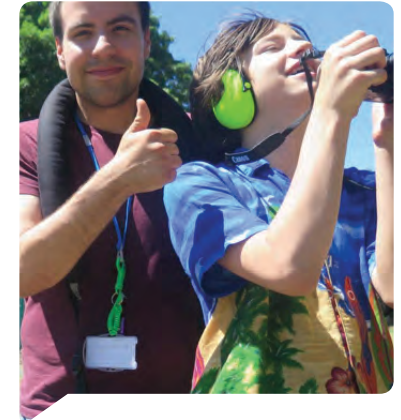

Your support will help us develop and deliver projects that enable people who are excluded through disability, disadvantage, ill-health, imprisonment, poverty or social isolation to take part in life changing creative arts experiences.

DAVE'S STORY

Dave took part in *Inside Stories*, a project through which young fathers in prison write, record and illustrate stories for their children, which they then set to music.

"The project taught me confidence, how to speak in front of people and about teamwork. I got to know the people I worked with and they told me about their kids and how much they mean to them, same as me. The atmosphere in the group was wicked!"

"It made me so happy putting everything together for my kids: I did it all for them. When I get out I'll definitely help them more with their homework. I'll help them write books when they're older, I'll stick things and draw with them. We'll have loads of fun!"

GINNY'S STORY

Ginny became a full-time carer when her daughter had a major psychotic breakdown. She took part in Create's *creative:voices* programme, through which adult carers use their own life experiences to inspire poetry and prose.

"Create's workshops are essential for carers, especially now, when services are so strapped for cash. Create told us, 'Yes, you are valued and you have other talents to discover too.'"

"The project has definitely changed me: I feel more positive and I see everyday life differently. Negativity and bad experiences can be made into positive ones when you've got time to reflect."
